



Math: Students will be focusing on Topics 8 and 9 which focus on fraction computation.

Reading: Students are wrapping up reading The Birchbark House and we will be focusing on comparing and contrasting Northwest Coast Peoples with the tribe The Birchbark House focused on. One way you can support your student at home would be to focus on comparing and contrasting in their own independent reading at home. You can talk to your student about what books they have read that are similar and different than the ones they are reading now, explaining why giving specific details to justify their thoughts.

Writing: Students will begin working on their opinion piece this month with a focus on comparing and contrasting ideas, using evidence to justify their opinions. This year we have focused heavily on how to write a strong introduction and conclusion paragraph and we will be continuing to focus on and practice these skills this month as well. Students will be heavily focused on using evidence to support their opinions and developing their arguments into an organized 5 paragraph piece of writing. One way you can support your student at home would be to have them practice writing short opinions about every day things using evidence to support their opinions that focus on organizing information.
