



November 25-29 - Enjoy your Thanksgiving Break -No School **Math**: Students will be focusing on Topic 4 where students will continue to focus on multiplication (two digit by two digit numbers.

Reading: Students will be focusing on legends this month. We will start by reading Hiawatha. Through this unit we will be focusing on interpreting theme in poetry and drama through text details. Students will also become familiar with the features that define a legend.

Writing: Students will identify features of a narrative and begin writing their own this month. An important part of writing a narrative is writing events in a sequence with plenty of details to paint a picture for the reader. We will be focusing heavily on dialogue and character development and how writers use tone to establish the mood in a narrative. In our last unit we focused heavily on how to write a strong introduction and conclusion paragraph and we will be continuing to focus on and practice these skills this month as well.
